

The development of one's mental attitudes and abilities are as important as the development of one's physical technique. As a matter of philosophy, Tae Kwon-Do students must be willing to give back to the art an equal measure of what they have received.

Promotional Testing is the most important day in the life of a Tae Kwon-Do student. It is on this day the student asks a panel of expert judges to evaluate the painstaking sacrifices that have been made thus far. It is on this day the student experiences the best that Black Belts have to offer by way of their precision, balance and demonstration of board breaking.

Students should show support of our program and to fellow students by their presence at special events, and be willing to sacrifice for the art of Tae Kwon-Do.

In order to be eligible to take a Promotional Testing, the following conditions must be met.

- A) Must have begun practice at least 30 days prior to scheduled Promotional Testing**
- B) Must have practiced consistently during the Testing cycle.**
- C) Must have attended the previous Promotional Testing. Failure to attend or excuse oneself from a Promotional Testing will result in an inactive membership status. A \$25.00 re-registration penalty will be charged upon returning. Excuse must be provided to the Judges' Panel by Testing day.**
- D) Must have attended at least 15 classes during the last Testing cycle.**
- E) Must have attended at least 20 classes during the last Testing cycle.**
- F) Must submit a Testing application, Photographs, and Thesis at least 30 days in advance of the scheduled Testing.**
- G) Must submit a Testing application at least 30 days in advance of the scheduled Testing.**
- H) Must have paid appropriate fees at least 30 days prior to the scheduled Testing.**
- I) Must inform the Judges' Panel at least 30 days in advance of the scheduled Testing desire to participate in Testing Demonstration.**
- J) Must have attended an average of 3 classes per week since last advancement.**
